Irish Climate

The Island of Ireland has a moderate climate with plentiful rainfall and rich soil which helps us grow nutritious grass – a critical factor for Lakeland Dairies grass based dairy farmers and the high quality milk they produce.

Grass Fed

Lakeland Dairies farmers are experts in managing pasture as a nutritious feed for cows full of protein, omega-3 and vitamins and minerals.



Did You Know?

The optimum height of a grass leaf for a cow to feed on is 10cm and should be no shorter than 4cm.

Beta Carotene

Grass on the Island of Ireland is rich in the pigment, Beta Carotene – the same pigment you find in carrots. This gives Lakeland Dairies' high quality dairy products their rich, yellow hue.
